

## **Pruning at the Villas**

Shrubs are to be trimmed below window height, away from air conditioners, off of fences and sidewalks to keep a maintained round shape. If shrubs have grown into each other, it will become a rounded hedge.

## **Round One (starting after Lilacs are done blooming, June/July)**

Lilac / Burning Bush / Viburnum / Dogwood / Weigela

## **Berms (starting after the condos are finished)**

Ninebark / Viburnum / Dogwood / Yew / Weigela

## **Tree Trimming (Once shrub pruning is done)**

Trees along roads are to be limbed up for mowing clearance, suckers trimmed

## **Round Two (August/September)**

Boxwood / Spirea

## **General Maintenance (when bedcare crew does weed control)**

Junipers are to be hand pruned to maintain natural shape, keeping off fences, sidewalks and air conditioners.

Any dead in plant material is to be trimmed to maintain overall look.

Trees around condos are to be maintained for mowing and sidewalk clearance as well as overall health of the tree.
