Open meetings are held monthly. The Board's primary duty is to be good stewards of the community's finances, which includes budget preparation and expenditure authorization. Further duties are responsibility for possible changes to our Rules and Regulations, review of homeowner change requests, complaint and problem solving, and oversight of our various committees.



#### **General qualifications:**

1.) Full-time residents are preferred to make meetings easier, but with various electronic means of communication available, "snow birds" can become candidates.

2.) Incumbent members are eligible to run for successive terms.

3.) Each homeowner unit will vote for up to two candidates. Over-voting will void that ballot.

4.) As in the past, proxies can be assigned. There are no provisions for absentee ballots.

5.) Additional nominations can be made at the meeting and ballots will be provided for that and/or write-ins.

This is your opportunity to join the board and make a difference.

The next step is to write a one hundred word (approx.) bio of yourself, describing why you have interest in becoming a Board member and your pertinent capabilities. Send the bio to Gary Krueger by September 27, 2024. This is to provide adequate time for ballot preparation and the October newsletter posting.


There are dead shrubs marked with a red flag throughout the campus. Lowney's will be removing these dead shrubs along with the red flags in the near future.

## Team USA Swimmer Torri Huske Edges Out Gretchen Walsh for 100-Meter Gold Medal After Walsh Set Olympic Record!

Jerry and Colette Huske's (2153 E. Sienna Way) granddaughter, Torri Huske, swam the 100-meter free and 100-meter butterfly plus a relay in the 2024 Paris Olympics. During a nail-biting butterfly race, American Torri Huske beat the competition for a first-place spot atop the podium, with Huske even edging out Team USA teammate Gretchen Walsh just one day after her recordsetting swim.

Huske, 21, won the women's 100-meter butterfly race, beating out Walsh, also 21, by .04 seconds in an exhilarating race that saw the latter take second place.

The wins — which mark the first time in 40 years that Team USA has gone one and two in the women's 100-meter butterfly — came just one day after Walsh broke the Olympic record in the same event's semifinals with a time of 55.38 seconds (Huske came in second during that race).

Torri will swim in the 100-meter Freestyle this Saturday, August 3, 2024.
